If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible. |
| Are there services covered before you meet your deductible? | Yes. <u>Emergency care</u> & <u>prescription drugs</u> ; plus <u>in-network</u> office visits & <u>preventive</u> are covered before you meet your deductible. | This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.

If you don't have **Minimum Essential Coverage** for a month, you'll have to make a payment when you file your tax return unless you qualify for an exemption from the requirement that you have health coverage for that month.

Does this plan Meet Minimum Value Standard? Yes.

If your **plan** doesn't meet the **Minimum Value Standards**, you may be eligible for a **premium tax credit** to help you pay for a **plan** through the **Marketplace**.
